INTRODUCTION

algoseek US Equity OTC Corporate Actions data provides comprehensive corporate actions information for Over-the-Counter (OTC) securities based on publicly available data from FINRA's OTC Equities Daily List feed (<https://otce.finra.org/otce/dailyList>).

Corporate actions are an important complement to market (pricing) data. They enable the construction of an accurate price history for a security over time by applying adjustment factors for corporate events such as dividends, splits, and similar distributions. They also allow the tracking of symbol and name changes, making it possible to understand the relationships between different securities that arise after acquisitions, mergers, and other corporate events.

The dataset covers six categories of corporate actions: security additions, security changes, security deletions, dividend additions, dividend changes, and dividend cancellations. Additional attributes included for each event are financial status, round lot quantity, market category, OATS reportability, and regulatory fee status.

Coverage: November 17, 2014, to present, with daily updates.

DATA SOURCE

algoseek US Equity OTC Corporate Actions dataset is built from the FINRA OTC Equities Daily List, published daily by the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (FINRA) at <https://otce.finra.org/otce/dailyList>.

The OTC Equities Daily List feed provides information about OTC securities, including additions to and deletions from the OTC market, symbol and name changes, security attribute changes, bankruptcy notifications, and dividend and distribution announcements. The Daily List is available intraday beginning at approximately 8:00 AM ET each trading day. In addition to current data, historical Daily List data is available from November 17, 2014.

Historical data for the period from November 17, 2014, through December 17, 2018, is sourced from FINRA Daily List archives (<https://otce.finra.org/otce/DailyList/archives>).

Data from December 18, 2018, onward is sourced from the FINRA public API (https://developer.finra.org/docs#query_api-equity-otc_daily_list).

Note: The data format changed on December 18, 2018. Several fields — including CorporateActionCode, CorporateActionId, DividendTypeDescription, DividendId, DividendADRFlag, DividendNonADRFlag, and all change-flag fields — are only available in the post-December 18, 2018 format. For earlier dates, these fields are always empty. See the Data Organization and File Format section for details.



Daily updates run each trading day (Monday–Friday) at multiple times throughout the day to capture intraday revisions to the Daily List. There are no updates on US market holidays (<https://us-equity-market-holidays.s3.amazonaws.com/holidays.csv>).

DATA ORGANIZATION AND FILE FORMAT

algoseek provides OTC Corporate Actions data in plain text CSV files. CSV files are gzip-compressed (having a .csv.gz extension). The first row of each CSV file is a fixed header followed by rows of data corresponding to individual corporate action events. Each file covers all events announced on a single trading day.

File naming: `yyyymmdd.csv.gz` — where `yyyymmdd` is the Corporate Action announcement date in the OTC Equities Daily List feed.

Record sorting: Records within each file are sorted by `AnnounceDate`, `AnnounceTime`, `EffectiveDate`, and `EffectiveTime`.

Table 1 (below) provides the name, type, default value when data is absent, and description for each field (column) in the CSV file.

The "Missing" column indicates the default value when a field is not present or not applicable:

- **Never** — the field is always populated for all records in that format
- **Blank** — the field may be empty when not applicable to the event type

Note: Fields marked with (*) are only populated for records from December 18, 2018, onward. For earlier dates, these fields are always blank regardless of event type.

Market Holidays

The stock market is closed for trading on most US holidays. CORPORATE ACTION EVENT TYPES

Each record in the dataset belongs to one of six corporate action event types, identified by the CorporateActionCode field. The six types and their subcategories are described below.

Note: For records before December 18, 2018, CorporateActionCode is always empty. The event category can still be inferred from the CorporateActionReason field (Table 2).

Table 2: Security Events and Dividend and Distribution Events

CorporateActionCode	Name	Description
SA	Security Addition	A security is being added to the OTC Equity Security Master. The record includes the new symbol, company name, market category, round lot, and other security attributes effective on the announced date.



SC	Security Change	One or more attributes of an existing security are changing (symbol, name, financial status, OATS reportability, round lot, market category, etc.). The record includes both the old (pre-change) and new (post-change) values.
SD	Security Deletion	A security is being removed from the OTC Equity Security Master. Reasons include acquisitions, delistings, bankruptcies, and regulatory actions.
DA	Dividend Addition	A new dividend, distribution, or split is being announced. This code is also used when a security attribute change and a distribution are announced simultaneously (e.g., forward splits, reverse splits, stock dividends).
DC	Dividend Change	A previously announced dividend or distribution record has been updated (e.g., a change in payment amount, dates, or other attributes).
DD	Dividend Deletion/Cancellation	A previously announced dividend or distribution has been cancelled.

Corporate Action Reason

The CorporateActionReason field provides a more detailed description of the event. Common reason values include:

Addition, Name Change, Symbol Change, Name/Symbol Change, Forward Split, Reverse Split, Stock Dividend Regular, Cash Dividend Regular, Acquisition/Merger/Amalgamation, Bankruptcy Plan Effective/Shares Cancelled, Market Center Change Delisted from NASDAQ, Market Center Change Listed on NYSE, Round Lot Size Update, Spin-Off, Redemption, Matured/Expired, Ineligible, and many others.

APPENDIX A. FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

What is the FINRA OTC Daily List?

The FINRA OTC Equities Daily List is published each trading day by the Financial Industry Regulatory Authority (FINRA) and provides announcements about OTC securities, including additions, deletions, symbol and name changes, security attribute changes, bankruptcy notifications, and dividend and distribution events. The list is available at <https://otce.finra.org/otce/dailyList>.

What are OTC securities?

Over-the-Counter (OTC) securities are equity securities that are traded on OTC markets rather than listed on a national exchange such as the NYSE or NASDAQ. OTC markets include the OTC Bulletin Board (OTCBB) and Other OTC markets. These are regulated by FINRA, which maintains the OTC Equity Security Master that records all active OTC securities and their attributes.

What is the difference between AnnounceDate and EffectiveDate?

AnnounceDate is the date the corporate action was published on the FINRA OTC Daily List (the announcement date). EffectiveDate is the date on which the change actually takes effect — for example, the date a symbol change becomes official, or the ex-date of a dividend. In many cases, an action is announced a few days before it takes effect.

Why are some fields always blank for records before December 18, 2018?

FINRA changed the format of the OTC Daily List on December 18, 2018, introducing several new fields via its API. Fields such as CorporateActionCode, CorporateActionId, EffectiveTime, DividendTypeDescription, DividendId, DividendADRFlag, DividendNonADRFlag, and all eleven Change...Flag fields did not exist in the legacy (pre-2018) format. For records sourced from the legacy format (November 17, 2014, through December 17, 2018), these fields are always empty. All other fields are available for the full history.

What does "Blank" mean in the Missing column?

"Blank" means the field will be an empty string in the CSV file when no data is available for that event. This is normal and expected — for example, CashAmount will be blank for a security addition event (no dividend is being announced), and NewTicker will be blank for a security attribute change where the symbol is not changing. "Never" means the field is always populated and will never be blank.



APPENDIX B. CORPORATE ACTION REASON DESCRIPTIONS

The CorporateActionReason field contains one of the values listed in Table 3 below. The table includes all reason descriptions that appear in the dataset, spanning both the legacy format (before December 18, 2018) and the current API format (from December 18, 2018 onward).
